Cascade Clamp - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop employing only four people. Overall sales for that particular year amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and various parts. Through 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is one of the leading global makers within the material handling trade.

Production and design of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business opportunities. During the last 60 years, the material handling trade has matured into a very complex field and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this development. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best provider of forklift accessories and various associated items. The company feels certain in their skill to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the international market.

During the nineteen fifties, Cascade started to fabricate, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was built in 1956, in order to accommodate all the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total employees reached 180 staff and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next manufacturing plant was built. 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are manufactured internationally because of many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is designed to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 subsequent to acquiring five corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international leader in forks.
