As they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the machine and are a lot less susceptible to destruction. Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This additional space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.
